Travelling Interstate?

There are several considerations for your pets when you take them interstate. On mainland Australia, they will meet new-to-them intestinal worms; rampant



fleas; paralysis tick; heartworm; and, for dogs, the newly emergent Ehrlicossus, carried by the Brown Dog Tick.

For your dog *NEXGARD SPECTRUM*, given monthly, copes with a lot of that. You can combine it with a *SERESTO COLLAR* [these last 8 months] against ehrlicossus, fleas & all ticks. There is an injection that confers 12 months protection from Heartworm. And each 3 months, a tapeworm treatment.

For cats an 8 month *SERESTO COLLAR* covers fleas and ticks. Add an *ALLWORMER* each 10-12 weeks. *MOXYCLEAR* prevents heartworm,

roundworm & fleas [but not ticks or tapeworm] ... no one treatment does it all!

... we can work through what is needed with you and develop a PLAN.

Decisions will be based on where you are going, how you are travelling, how long you will be away.

Also full C5 or F4 vaccination cover is encouraged, so you can be ready to put them in kennels if you need to, especially with the many unexpected upsets that can interfere with travel at present.

Safe and secure travel boxes, harnesses, name-tags AND up-to-date Microchip data may be needed?

When you return to Tasmania: keep your pets on Heartworm prevention for at least a further 3 months. And your dog will need Praziquantel tapeworm treatment against Hydatids + evidence of being Brown Dog Tick-free before entering Tasmania.
